WE HAD EARLIER ASKED THE FRENCH MILATT TO TRY TO CONFIRM WHETHER OR NOT PARIS PLANNED TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION TO BURUNDI FOR THE OAU FORCE, BUT HE WAS UNABLE TO DO SO.
