- 2. SUMMARY: THE PL, PSD AND MDR REMAIN DEADLOCKED OVER THE APPOINTMENT OF THE PRIME MINISTER FOR THE NEXT TRANSITION GOVERNMENT. THE DIPLOMATIC COMMUNITY FEARS THAT A PROLONGED DEADLOCK COULD JEOPARDIZE THE PLACE ACCORD BUT MOSTLY ESCHEWS TAKING SIDES.

COMMENT: I HAVE REPEATED TO MUGENZI AND OTHERS HERE MY WARNING THAT WESTERM CAPITALS WILL NOT UNDERSTAND IF THIS DEADLOCK RESULTS IN A DEFERRAL OF I HAVE URGED COMPROMISE, INCLUDING THE PEACE ACCORD. THE CONSIDERATION OF SUCH MECHANISMS AS THE INNER CABINET WHICH WAS PROPOSED EARLIER AS A MEANS OF FORCING THE PRIME MINISTER TO CONSULT WITH HIS MINISTER OF DEFENSE GASANA TOLD ME THAT COLLEAGUES.
