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THE PANELS OF JUDGES FOR THE TWO TRIBUNALS SHOULD BE TAILORED TO EACH SITUATION, I.E. NOT INTERCHANGEABLE. END SUMMARY.

A SEPARATE TRIBUNAL

3. ACCORDING TO QUAI IO HUMAN RIGHTS DESK OFFICER SOPHIE LAZLO, THE GOF CONSIDERS IT ESSENTIAL THAT A NEW AND SEPARATE TRIBUNAL BE FORMALLY CREATED TO DEAL WITH RWANDA WAR CRIMES. THE GOF AGREES THAT THE TRIBUNAL COULD SHARE THE SAME ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL AND FACILITIES BUT WANTS THE RWANDA TRIBUNAL TO BE A SEPARATE ENTITY. THE GOF IS NOT IN FAVOR OF RETROACTIVELY CHANGING THE SCOPE OF AN INSTITUTION SUCH AS THE YUGOSLAV WAR CRIMES TRIBUNAL.

DIFFERENT CLASSES OF CRIMES

THE GOF BELIEVES THAT THE DIFFERENT TYPES OF CRIMES 4. THAT TOOK PLACE IN FORMER YUGOSLAVIA AND RWANDA SHOULD FORMER PROSECUTED IN THE SAME TRIBUNAL. LAZLO POINTED CONFIDENTIAL

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OUT THAT THE YUGOSLAV TRIBUNAL WILL JUDGE WAR CRIMES WHEREAS THE RWANDA TRIBUNAL WOULD BE DEALING WITH GENOCIDE.

DIFFERENT JUDGES REQUIRED

5. THE GOF AGREES THAT ADDITIONAL TRIAL CHAMBERS WOULD HEED TO BE CREATED TO HANDLE RWANDAN CASES IF THE YUGOSLAV WAR CRIMES TRIBUNAL IS TO BE EXPANDED. THE GOF DOES NOT AGREE, HOWEVER, WITH THE CONCEPT THAT "EACH CHAMBER WOULD BE ELIGIBLE TO HANDLE CASES ARISING OUT OF EACH SITUATION." ACCORDING TO LAZLO, THE GOF POSITION IS THAT NEW JUDGES SHOULD BE SELECTED FOR THE RWANDA WAR CRIMES TRIBUNAL BASED ON THEIR QUALIFICATIONS TO HANDLE THE SPECIFIC TYPE OF CASES THEY WILL FACE, AND WOULD NOT NECESSARILY BE FUNGIBLE WITH YUGOSLAV TRIBUNAL JUDGES.

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6. DESPITE THESE SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENCES, LAZLO TOLD US THE GOF CONSIDERS ITS POSITION TO BE "CLOSE ENOUGH" TO THAT OF THE UNITED STATES TO PERMIT THE OUTSTANDING DIFFERENCES TO BE BRIDGED.

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
