Implementation of weapons impounding measures

- 1. As part of the monitoring of the Kigali weapons impounding zone on 13 January 1994, Col. BEM Marchal has sent Col. Purtcscher, Chief of the UNAMIR observers for Kigali sector on a field mission to monitor the weapons the impounding of weapons and ammunition depots, particularly the anti-aircraft artillery and the position on Mount Kigali.
- 2. Col. Purtscher accompanied by me, toured the following locations:
 - (a) The Kigali, Kacyiru, Kimihurura and Col. Mayuya camps
 Each camp has three anti-aircraft guns and their ammunition is in the depots (No remarks).
 - (b) The airport: Nine anti-aircraft guns are deployed around the airport, and their ammunition is stored in shelters at the battalion commander's command post. (No remarks)
 - (c) On Mount Kigali: two companies from the Huye commando battalion are deployed on Mount Kigali. The soldiers at the position are in possession of the weapons and ammunition. It is indeed true that on Mount Kigali, neither the weapons nor the ammunition have been impounded due to lack of shelters or tents for their storage, as each soldier only has an individual tent.
 - (d) Col. Purtscher and his two UNAMIR observers said that two large section tents should be located and set up in each company for storing the ammunition. They said that if no tents are available, the ammunition should be taken to Kigali camp. It was agreed that two section tents would be set up at the position for storage of ammunition. The [illegible] Company will provide two tents to the Huye commando battalion.

- 3. It took a long time to tour these positions: 1000-1200 for Kigali and 1400-1600 for Kanombe, because Col. Purtscher insisted on checking each firing point to ensure that weapons anti-aircraft weapons were not [illegible].
- 4. <u>Conclusion</u>: Col. Purtscher is of the view that the weapons impounding measures have been executed in all the military camps, except at the position on Mount Kigali.

He asked me to inform him as soon as the tents were set up at Mount Kigali. As the ammunition is to be stored in a location not far from the soldiers, tents, even used ones, arrangements will be made to locate tents at the Quarter-master's company and set up by 17 January 1994.


