Request for Contingency Planning Gor Rossible SUBJECT: Military-Assisted Evacuation Operation of American Citizens in Rwanda

The situation in Kigali, Rwanda has detectorated rapidly. S/S-O Fighting has broken out as a result of the cooths of the RF/CWA Presidents of Rwanda and Burundi, who were abound a commercial aircraft that is believed to have been downed by hoskille files as it approached the Kigali airport on April 6, 1990.
Personnel assigned to the United Nations Assistance Mission in Rwanda (UNAMIR) have been killed, and signifing has backen out

in Kigali between government military Gorces and Gorces of the Rwandan Patriotic Front (RPF).

Currently all official Americans in Records are reported to be safe and have been directed to remain the Residences. The total number of U.S. citizens in Rwandards escalmated between 210 and 350. The Department of State requests the Department of Defense immediately begin active contingency planning for a possible military-assisted evacuation operation of all U.S. citizens in Rwanda. Planning should include a full range of options. We request that this planning take into consideration possible combined operations with allied countries that have citizens in Rwanda, such as France and Belgium. This planning should also consider the possible evacuation of allied civilians in Rwanda.
