# SITREP COVERING PERIOD 0306008 FEB TO 0406008 FEB 94.

I. <u>GEN SITUATION</u>: Apparently calm. It was reported that on 030400 Feb: 94 a grenade was thrown to a group of people from a car in NYAKABANDA area. Two persons were injured and brought to KIGALI hospital. At 10.00 Hrs a grenade was found in KICUKIRO area by KIBAT troops. On 031530 Feb 94 a total of 4 rounds of rifle firing were heard in the KIMIHURURA area. Inquiry took place but no results.

## II. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. <u>POLITICAL</u>. The SRSG held consultations with several political leaders aimed at resolving the impasse on the installation of the Broad Based Transitional Government and the Transitional National Assembly. A detailed report on these consultations will be sent to you under separate cover:

#### B. MILITARY.

- (1) RGY, NTR.
- (2) RPF. NTR.
- (3) OTHERS. RPF reported an alleged clash at NYAGATARE (3656) between refugees returning from UGANDA and RGF forces. The incident took place in the morning of 03 Feb 94 and resulted in minor clashes between opposing forces. The refugees were on their way to TABAGUYE (2358). MILOB RGF Sec and RPF Sec were tasked to investigate.

### III. ONN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. HOS. FC attended a meeting at ministerial level on implementation of Kigali Weapon Secure Area 80Ps. Progress was made and offensive recovery of arms caches activities led. by Gendarmeria under UNAMIR supervision will be organized.

#### B. SECTORS.

(1) KIGALI. Sec KIGALI conducted vehicle and foot Ptl in KIGALI city in order to ensure Kigali Weapon Secure Area. Provided 2 UNMO escorts for RPF, 2 for Gendarmerie and 1 for the prime minister. Provide 1 armed escort for the prime minister and 2 for RPF personnel. Secured the location of the RPF battalion in KIGALI city, the prime minister's office, Force HQ, Sec HQ and KIGALI airport. During the night assured protection of the prime minister, the prime minister
