4. AMBA8SADOR INDERFURTH REPLIED AS FOLLOWS:

D) CONCERNING CRITERIA FOR DETENTION WE BELIEVED REQUIREMENT IN PARA 7 OF DRAFT RESOLUTION TO KEEP THE SYG INFORMED OF ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH DETENTION WAS ADEQUATE SAFEGUARD AND WE NEED NOT ELABORATE CRITERIA BEYOND WHAT WAS IN PARA 3 OF DRAFT.

5. UK QUERIED WHETHER AFRICANS WOULD ACCEPT CHAPTER VII REFERENCE, FRENCH QUERIES USE OF TERM "AUTHORIZE" ON GROUNDS IT MIGHT BE SUPEREROGATORY. ALL THREE PROMISED TO REPORT TEXT AND SEEK RAPID INSTRUCTIONS.
