• (U) The RPF has charged that massacres by elements of the Army and MRND-CDR (Republican National Movement for Democracy and Development - Coalition for the Defense of the Republic) are still going on in many parts of the country. It estimates that between 10,000 and 20,000 people have died in and around Kigali, including 30 Red Cross employees of Rwandan origin killed by government troops. (FBIS)

• (LOU) Zaire's President Mobutu has alleged that the plane crash which killed the two presidents was part of a larger plot to destabilize the region and has called for an international investigation. Zairian TV is suggesting that Belgium is behind events and is decrying the abandonment of Rwandans by foreign residents. (Kinshasa 2123)

• (LOU) Refugee flows into Zaire are reported to be on the increase, with 10,000 estimated to have crossed from Rwanda since the crisis began. There are fewer refugees moving to Tanzania, however. The UNHCR has indicated that it will release \$5 million from its emergency fund to cover immediate needs. (Kinshasa 2123, Geneva 3602)
